

Privacy Policy

Effective from 01/01/2012

SaRC (New Zealand) Ltd ("SaRC") is committed to ensuring the privacy of your personal information in accordance with the provisions of the Privacy Act 1993 ("Privacy Act").

This policy may be updated from time to time. We recommend that you revisit this policy periodically to ensure you are aware of the latest policy.

Collection of personal information

SaRC collects personal information direct from all members for the purpose of maintaining its newsletter mailing list, this may be obtained through the website, in person, by email or other generally accepted method of personal communication. We also collect more detailed personal information from those who choose to join as Social Club members. The information is used as stated below.

Subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act, you have the right to access the information held about you and have it corrected if it is wrong.

If you wish to unsubscribe from any newsletter, you may opt-out by clicking the Unsubscribe link or by contacting us. In most cases, this will involve your terminating your membership of SaRC.

We also collect information about your activity on this website. This information is used for statistical purposes and to maintain or improve the quality of the operation of the community.

Security of information

SaRC will take all reasonable safeguards against loss, misuse or disclosure of the personal information provided.

Use of personal contact information

The information received from members is used for internal record keeping, for communication, statistical and market research purposes, to deliver the services you have requested, and to help tailor the SaRC community to suit its members.

Subject to the exceptions provided in the Privacy Act, SaRC will not disclose information that will personally identify you without your express permission.

Should other members request your contact details, SaRC will not disclose them without your express agreement. This agreement may be obtained by SaRC via email, text, letter or phone call. If you choose to pass your contact details to another member, SaRC accepts no liability for the dissemination of that information.

Generic and demographic data may be used for the purposes of promoting the SaRC community to potential advertisers, the media and partners who will provide benefits to our members and to the community as a whole. Individual members will not be identified.
